

JN Easyrider 2006

Kite sizes 5, 7.5, 10, 13 and 16.5 m



PERFORMANCE

The Easyrider is new to the JN line this year. It's the weapon of choice for the JN wave riders and a reliable partner for any advanced freestyle lesson. Michael Nesler's design briefing did read like a complex menu: The kite should reach as close as possible the competition performance of a Prima Donna combined with increasing stability in gusty winds, very good relaunch comfort using a five-line or four-line system and an extreme depower ability. The result is a powerful, good-natured and error-forgiving kite. Especially when using a bar one size shorter, you can take out some of the very sportive reaction speed. Thanks to the adaptable turning speed and medium bar pressure, it is a gentle companion when learning new moves. A sound ground pull and no compromises in design regarding upwind capabilities allow a wide wind range.

RELAUNCH

Relaunch is made easier than ever before. The Easyrider flips over and into launch position almost all by itself. Super easy and quick with fifth line in all wind conditions. Also fine with JN four-line CBS.

SAFETY

After safety release the kite turns automatically (attached on the fifth line) into starting position and waits for relaunch at the wind window edge. Safety was a huge factor in the design of the new Alex quick release, depower loop quick release and safety leash quick

release.

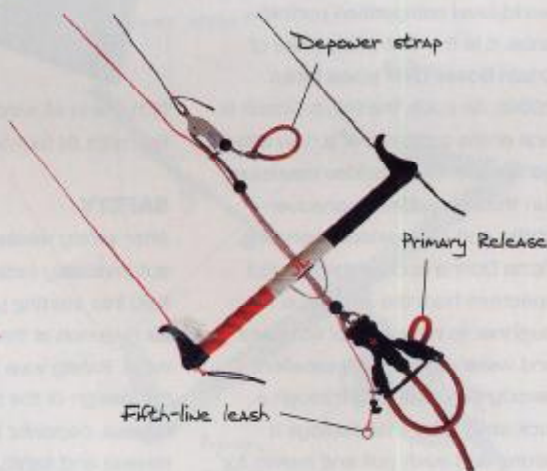

JN Prima Donna 2006

PERFORMANCE

The Prima Donna was designed to provide a harmonic balance between outstanding handling and world-level competition performance. It is the first-choice kite of Kristin Boese (first place PKRA 2006). As such, the Prima Donna is one of the outriders of a new kite generation that provides maximum fun through optimal maneuverability and silky-smooth handling. Prima Donna excites the full pilot spectrum from the ambitious beginner to new-school acrobats and wake stylers, with excellent aerodynamic stability through a rock-solid wing that deploys a strong and even pull and makes for extended hang times. The Prima Donna has favorable, easy-to-control handling throughout the full spectrum of maneuvers. By newly defining the center of lift and saving weight by shaping a thinner front tube and struts, the Prima Donna takes off in very light wind.
